# Aleksei Vyzhanov

in his own words...



My story began with an orchestral debut as a piano soloist in my hometown at eight years old. Since then I have performed across Russia and in France, Germany, Austria, Spain and the United States.

Holding a master's degree from Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory under Professor Vladimir Ovchinnikov and an artist diploma at Texas Christian University under Dr. Tamás Ungár, I am now pursuing a doctor of musical arts degree at the University of North Texas under Dr. Pamela Mia Paul.

As a concert musician I have performed at the Saint Petersburg House of Music as part of a prestigious concert series offered for audiences all over Russia. I worked with the Texas Christian University Opera Studio on the inaugural production of the opera *Yeltsin in Texas* and with the Texas Christian University Symphony Orchestra as a collaborative pianist.

My achievements include awards from numerous international competitions and festivals including the Skryabin Open Festival and Competition, Igumnova International Festival and Competition of Young Pianists, and concerts with the Orchestra Open Competition of Young Performers, Sforzando International Youth Classical Music Competition and River of Talents Musical Project.

In addition, I have performed as a soloist in a concert series with the Nizhny Novgorod Symphony Orchestra, Voronezh State Symphony Orchestra, Tambov State Symphony Orchestra and Lipetsk Symphony Orchestra.

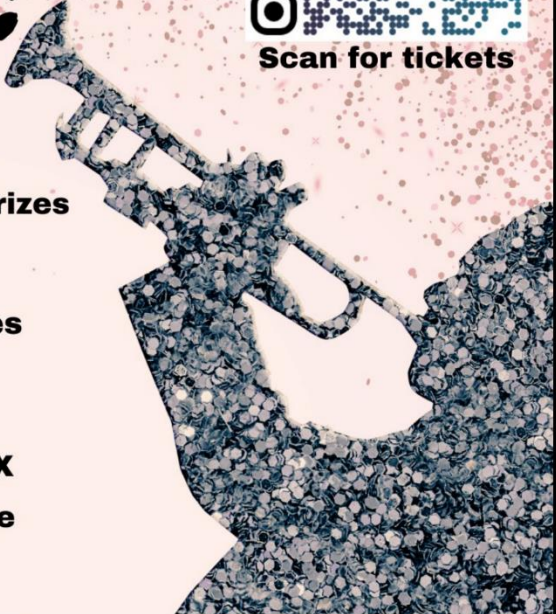

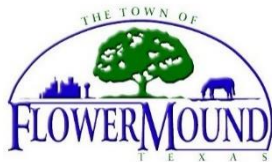
